



Election Results, MRO Board of Directors

Saint Paul, MN. On November 26, 2018, MRO solicited nominations from its members for an open Investor Owned Utility (IOU) Sector seat on the MRO Board of Directors with a term ending December 31, 2020. Pursuant to Section 7.3 of the MRO Bylaws, this position was open to all members of the IOU Sector with less than 3,000 megawatts of end-use load.

Two individuals were nominated for this position, and the IOU Sector conducted an electronic ballot to elect its board representative. We are pleased to announce that Mr. Darcy Neigum from Montana-Dakota Utilities Company was elected to represent the IOU Sector on the MRO Board beginning January 1, 2019.
