

Election Results, MRO Board of Directors

Saint Paul, MN. On November 6, 2018, the Midwest Reliability Organization (MRO) Board of Directors nominated three Independent Directors and two Regional Directors to all MRO members for election to the board. That election period closed on November 20, and we are pleased to announce the election results:

Independent Directors

- Incumbent Dr. Paul Barber, elected for a three-year term ending December 31, 2021
- Jeanne Tisinger, elected for a three-year term ending December 31, 2021
- Julius Cox, elected for a three-year term ending December 31, 2021

Regional Directors

- Jennifer Flandermeyer, Kansas City Power and Light, elected for a three-year term ending December 31, 2021
- Stuart Lowry, Sunflower Electric Power Corporation, elected for a three-year term ending December 31, 2021

Additionally, on October 22, 2018, MRO solicited nominations from its members for industry sector seats open on the MRO Board of Directors as of January 1, 2019. Several nominations were received for these positions, and between November 6 and November 20, 2018, electronic ballots were conducted in each membership sector. We are pleased to announce the following industry sector election results:

Canadian Utility Sector

- Incumbent Tony Clark, Manitoba Hydro was reelected for a three-year term ending December 31, 2021

Cooperative Sector

- Incumbent Gordon Pietsch, Great River Energy, was reelected for a three-year term ending December 31, 2021

Federal Power Marketing Agency Sector

- Incumbent Lloyd Linke, Western Area Power Administration, was reelected for a three-year term ending December 31, 2021

Generator and/or Power Marketer Sector

- Incumbent Silvia Parada Mitchell, NextEra Energy Resources, was reelected for a three-year term ending December 31, 2021
