



MRO Launches Align Webpage

SAINT PAUL, MINN. MRO launched an Align webpage to serve as a resource for registered entities to go and see quick access links to the NERC Align and ERO Secure Evidence Locker (SEL) training materials, NERC Align FAQ's, the Align training environment, and the ERO help desk ticketing system that will be utilized for Align and ERO SEL technical support. The recording of registered entity Align and SEL training that was provided on both February 23, 2021 and March 3, 2021, is also available on this webpage.

As a reminder all registered entities' Primary Compliance Contacts (PCC's) should review the training material before March 31, 2021. The PCC has the sole ability initially to approve access requests for Align for other users at the individual's entity.
